Here are a couple of things to remember at this event.

<u>Pit-Out Blend Line</u>: Exiting the pit lane watch the Starter for Direction, Stay Driver's right of the Blend Line all the way to Turn 1. Please watch your mirrors for overtaking cars.

<u>Yellow Flag Rules</u>: Please review GCR Section 6.1.B for the Yellow Flag Rules. The New Language defines the NO Pass Zone more clearly than in the past. It also has stronger language about the Club's expectation for Driver's to Slow Down. I encourage all Drivers to signal to the Flaggers that they have seen the Yellow Flag and react to the Flag appropriately. We really don't want to ruin anyone's race by having to penalize someone for unsafe speed through an incident. The Rules are there to protect you and the Race Officials.

Racing Room: If a Driver is involved in Body Contact the Driver and Car shall stop at Black Flag for Review of the incident by The Stewards. The investigations for contact will take place in the impound area.

<u>On Track Sessions</u>: Please review the race schedule for both Saturday and Sunday. Be prepared and listen to the pages for your race group.

There will be a worker/competitor party at the conclusion of Saturday's activities please plan to join us.
