Roads Scholar National Course Rally on Saturday will be a 180 mile rally through the marvelous Wisconsin countryside on some of the best rally roads in America. Designed for experienced rallyists, it will have a variable main road rule as well as both Numbered and Lettered instructions. It will not have Aristotle traps or 'Absence of the sign' traps. Speeds are moderate and free zones are used extensively. Timing will be done with traditional, open, manned controls and a few DIYC controls. The rally route will include about 3 miles of high quality, unpaved roads.

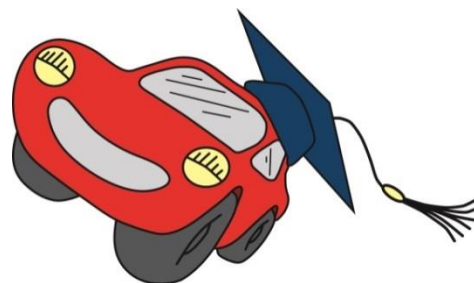
Roads Scamper National Tour Rally on Sunday will be a scenic 180 mile tour rally that will use the Richta GPS checkpoint app for all control timing. Each team will be required to have a smartphone with an active cellular data service. This app will run on your smartphone during the rally and will use the GPS signals to automatically time you in at each control with a resolution of 0.1 second. It will report your arrival time and your leg score to you moments after each control. This event will feature approximately 100 timing controls, some in more challenging locations. The rally route will include about 5 miles of high quality unpaved roads. **Pre-registration is required.**
